

Employment Law Update: The New Year will Bring New Minimum Wage Rates

12/27/21

Effective January 1, 2022, <u>New Jersey's statewide minimum wage</u> for most employees will increase from \$12.00 per hour to \$13.00 per hour. The following minimum wage rates will also go into effect:

- Tipped employees: \$5.13 per hour;
- Seasonal and small employers with fewer than 6 employees: \$11.90 per hour;
- Agricultural employees and piece-rate wage: \$11.05 per hour; and
- Long-term care facility staff: \$16.00 per hour.
